What is Bike & Ride?

It's a secure, enclosed bicycle parking facility with card access and space for over 100 bikes. It's located in the first floor of the Metro garage at College Park-U of MD station.

How it works:



Get a BikeLink™ card

Order at wmata.com/bikeandride or (888) 540-0546. Card will arrive by mail.



1st time ID verification

For your security, ID verification via camera takes only a few minutes. One-time \$5 charge deducted from card for this service.



Park and retrieve your bike

Insert card. Press button to confirm you are either parking or picking up bike. Door will unlock when you remove card.



Rates & Rules

5¢/hr. 8 a.m. - 12 a.m. 2¢/hr. other times.

- Do not allow entry to others.
- BikeLink card is non-transferable.
- Exit within 10 minutes of entering.
- Card number must be displayed on bike (stickers provided with card.)
- Always lock your bike inside.

- Secure bike parking whenever you need it, 24/7.
- Park for a few hours, overnight or for several days.
- Your stored-value card is your key to the facility. It's secure, easy to use and never expires.

Bikes and Metro

- Bikes are allowed onboard Metrorail anytime except on weekdays, 7-10 a.m. and 4-7 p.m., and during special events when the system is crowded.
- Folded bicycles are allowed on Metrorail anytime.
- Please use the elevators, not the escalators.
- You can bring your bike on the bus, too.
 The front of every Metrobus has a rack for two bikes. Load your bike and go!



Frequently Asked Questions

How much does it cost? Rental rates are 5¢/hr between 8am and 12am, 2¢/hr at other times. The BikeLink card costs \$20. After your ID check, it will have \$15 of rental value on it. There's no annual or monthly fee and no service plan.

What's the maximum rental duration? What happens if I return late? Maximum rental duration is 10 days. Your bike is subject to impoundment if you leave it longer than the maximum rental duration.

What is BikeLink? Metro has teamed with BikeLink to operate the facility and provide a new kind of bike parking.

Can I add value to my card? Yes, just go to www.bikelink.org, or call (888) 540-0546.

What if I lose my card? Email BikeLink at info@bikelink. org or call us at (888) 540-0546. We will block access for your lost card at group parking facilities like College Park.

Why does it cost \$5 to use it the first time? The ID verification feature provides additional security for BikeLink facilities like College Park where users all share a single parking room. The \$5 fee helps defray the cost of doing the ID verification.

Why charge for bike parking at all? The minimal fee keeps non-commuters from using the Bike & Ride as a personal storage unit, and helps offset our operating costs.

Can I pay with my SmarTrip® card? Unfortunately no, you must use a BikeLink card. Metro is planning the next generation SmarTrip® card now, and in the long term we will work to accept the SmarTrip® card.

Will my BikeLink card work at any BikeLink facility? Your BikeLink card will work at any BikeLink facility. College Park is the first east coast BikeLink location.

What if I do not have enough value on my card when I return? We don't want to leave you stranded. You can still get your bike, but your card will be zeroed out and will be unable to start a new rental until you add value to it.
